

ICD-10 Testing Summary and Facility Requirements

Testing Summary

TruBridge is available to participate in testing with any payer that allows ICD-10 testing. It is important to note that our testing is *submitter level testing only*; therefore, we will only be able to use your data if we serve as your clearinghouse. If we do not serve as your clearinghouse, please contact your third party vendor to schedule ICD-10 submitter level testing.

Payers requiring testing are given priority. If your payer is providing testing but it is not requiring submitter level testing please contact TruBridge to schedule testing. Please see the requirements below in order to participate in ICD-10 testing.

Requirements to Participate in any ICD-10 Testing

- 1. Your facility must be using the new Grouper
- 2. Your facility must have dual coded accounts

In order to participate with TruBridge in any ICD-10 testing your facility will need to be on the 1915.27 or greater release. If you need assistance with the new Grouper or dual coding please contact CPSI Financial Software Support after you have reviewed the CPSI ICD-10 Update, available in the User Area of our website.
